Look for the R4R sign.

From I-5 S. Take the CA-20 exit, EXIT 578, toward COLUSA/CLEAR LAKE. Turn West onto CA-20 go 36.8 mi. then Turn LEFT onto CA-53 S. go 7.5 mi. then Turn RIGHT onto LOWER LAKE RD CA-29. go 1.3 mi. and Turn LEFT onto SEIGLER CANYON RD. go 4.0 mi. and Turn RIGHT to stay on SEIGLER CANYON RD. go 0.6 mi. and SEIGLER CANYON RD becomes LOCH LOMOND RD go 3.4 mi. and Turn LEFT onto CA-175. After 0.2 mi. you will End at Big Pines Campground Cobb, CA

From US-101 N. toward EUREKA.

Take the exit toward RIVER RD/ GUERNEVILLE. After 0.2 mi. Turn RIGHT onto MARK WEST SPRINGS RD. go 5.4 mi. and MARK WEST SPRINGS RD becomes PORTER CREEK RD. go another 4.6 mi. and Turn LEFT onto FOOTHILL BLVD CA-128. Go 0.8 mi. and Turn RIGHT onto TUBBS LN. go 1.3 mi. and Turn LEFT onto CA-29/LAKE COUNTY HWY CALISTOGA GRADE RD. Continue to follow CA-29. Go 14.9 mi. and Turn LEFT onto CA-175/MAIN ST. Continue to follow CA-175. Then go 11.5 mi. and End at Big Pines Campground Cobb, CA
